### **A Word From Pastor Dave.....**

What a grand month we experienced in May! Mother's Day, Youth Sunday, a wonderful potluck with great food and a new spirit of fellowship as we re-dedicated ourselves to Christ's mission in this place. Thank you for your participation that day and for your generous support of our congregational ministries. You are Kent Memorial, and it is through your work and witness that the Church of Christ continues to grow.

This last Sunday, on Pentecost, Allen Brumm also re-dedicated his life to Christ as he affirmed his faith in the Rite of Confirmation, an important step in his life towards greater Christian maturity and towards a more active role in the life of the church. We also wished Adam Kralina, Brittany Hansen, (and Jessica Jung who was at a family gathering) congratulations on their graduation from high school. Thank you for being there and showing your support for these fine young Christians. I also want to thank Gerry Williams for emceeding these two events and for his encouraging words to us and to these young people.

This coming Sunday we will honor our Veterans ( An Honor Guard from the American Legion will be present at the end of the 8:00 service) - and thank them for their service to our country. We hope you can be here as we begin our summer schedule and our outdoor worship services. Remember the late service begins at 10:00.

This Memorial Day weekend is also Trinity Sunday. With Trinity Sunday, we come to the second half of the church year. The first half ran from Advent to Pentecost. Since the great festivals of Christ fall in the first half of the year, it is natural that the life of Christ is emphasized then. In the second half of the year which follows Pentecost, the lessons focus on Jesus' teachings and on the Spirit and His work among us.

Trinity Sunday is the first Sunday after Pentecost. It is one of the earliest and certainly the most important of the doctrinal festivals. The long season which follows is called the Season After Pentecost, and the Sundays are numbered "after Pentecost rather than "after Trinity." The Sundays after Pentecost represent the time of the Church - the time between the earthly ministry of Jesus, which is past, and the consummation, which is ahead. The Pentecost Season is a time of growth in the Spirit as the risen Christ is formed in us. Be sure to be a part of our on-going ministry of the church. For us to do the work the Lord has given us, we need you!

Drink lots of water and eat lunch before donating—and bring a friend!

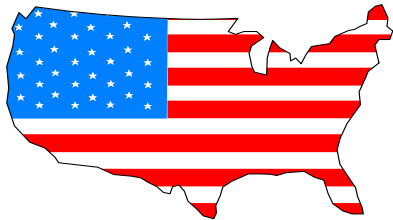

### *The Springfield Symphony Orchestra Featuring the Lake Area Chorale*

The presentation of symphonic music has been a summertime tradition of the Lake Arts Council for many years. It will continue this summer, but in a new location with a new orchestra.

After several contacts and interviews by the Performing Arts Committee with the Springfield Symphony Music Director, Ron Spigelman, we are confident that this will be the beginning of something very fine for our community.

Mr. Spigelman asked during an initial interview, if there was within our community a group such as a choir or chorale. He explained that he likes to draw on the strengths of a community in the development of his programs. To recommend the Lake Area Chorale was an easy decision. Many of you were present on March 10 when the Lake Area Choral sang in the high school auditorium in com-

bination with the Kansas City Men's Chorus. That marvelous performance is another indicator that this upcoming program is one not to be missed.

***The date to save is Saturday, June 26, 2010.*** The music will begin at **7:30 PM** in the Worthan Auditorium of the Camdenton High School located south of Highway 54 off of Laker Pride Road.

The auditorium seats 900 people. We will have reserved seating for those who wish to make that type of arrangement. Those seats will be in the front middle sections of the auditorium. ***The reserved seating price is \$25 for adults.*** Reservations must be made by calling the Lake Arts Council office at **964-6366**, between the hours of 9 am and 1 pm. Discover, Masters, and Visa credit cards will be accepted.

***All student seats are \$10.*** If you are reserving an adult seat and are obtaining student seats as well please, be sure to indicate whether you want those student tickets in the reserved section.

General Admission tickets may be purchased at the door the evening of the performance or for your convenience at these following locations: Paul's Supermarkets in Osage Beach and Lake Ozark, Wilson's Music in Eldon, First National Banks in Camdenton, Community Bank in Sunrise Beach, and the Health Mart Pharmacy in Laurie.

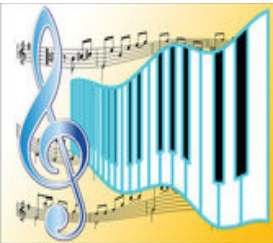
