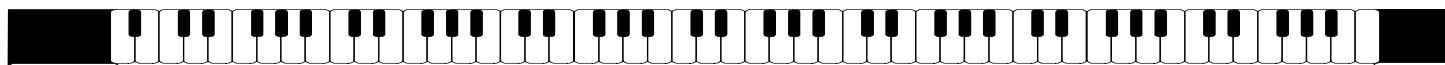

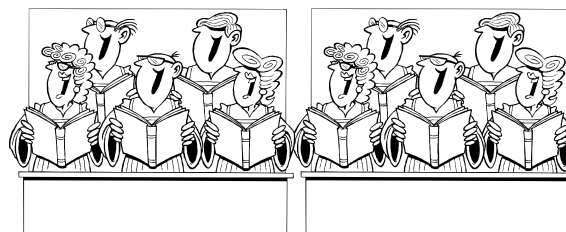

Meeting called to order at 6:02 p.m.

Pastor Beese presented the devotion from the July issue of *The Lutheran*.

Motion by Linda Kimberling to approve the minutes from the June meeting as presented, second by Chuck Wanamaker, motion carried.

Discussion was held regarding Kent's financial situation. Motion by Pat Larson to approve the Treasurer's report as presented, second by Linda Kimberling, motion carried.

Motion by Gail Kruse to approve the Building Fund report as presented, second by Jerry Husbands, motion carried.

Pastor's report: *Vacation Bible School is in session this week, July 9-13. Although attendance is down from last year, we have great leadership, and everyone is having a good time Abby Kruse and Sydni Irwin are the youth helpers from Kent. Kent has 6 youngsters attending. *Bible Camp starts next Sunday afternoon, July 15 and continues through noon July 20. *Renew, Revive, Rekindle is scheduled for Sunday, July 22, after the second service, where we will welcome the 12 new members who have joined Kent over the past year, and invite them to become involved in the various aspects of the Kent Memorial family life.

Available committee reports were presented. *Leeanne Brumm is stepping down as Preschool Sunday School teacher, but Gail Kruse and Carol Hansen have agreed to teach, with additional backup to be secured. *Property committee has negotiated a new contract for our propane supply, which should show some savings in that expense. *Worship and Music has solicited an estimate for the cost of installing flagstones in the altar area of the Ireland Outdoor Worship area, to make footing more secure during communion and weddings. 10 more hymnals have been ordered. *Evangelism: Important dates to remember: **August 3 & 4**, Rummage Sale **September 7**, Trivia Night & Silent Auction **September 21**, Guess Who's Coming to Dinner? **October 18**, Day trip to Branson to see "Joseph" at Sight and Sound Theater.

After discussion, motion by Gail Kruse to offer the position of Handbell Choir Director to Toni Wagner, second by Linda Kimberling, motion carried. *Discussion followed regarding an appropriate token of appreciation from the council for Jan Ellis' years of service to Kent Memorial. Motion by Barb Yount to give Jan a music box and a gift card.

Kent Klowns - Linda Williams told of the wonderful time the Klowns had in Kimberling City, some experiences they had, and that one never knows where one's mission is going to be. They received many blessings from the congregation there.

Senior Center - Nothing to report.

Sunshine Lady - Lorraine reported she sent three get well cards.

Publicity - Janet Harger - Janet had handouts for the rummage sale and has put advertising on the radio and in the newspaper.

Care Core - Sue Olson said she still needed two coordinators for two months of Care Core. Other than that all is OK.

Social Ministry - Ann Say spoke about Trivia Night. Ann chairs the event, Evelyn Clements chairs the Silent Auction. There will be tables of 8, with teams of 8. There will also be door prizes. Everyone bring some appetizers for the event. It will be held on September 7th.

Pampered Chef - Peggy Mueller presented a check to WELCA for \$610.94. The total sales from the party were \$3,040. Peggy added in her sales percentage to give us the \$610.94 total. It was suggested that this become a yearly event.

Barb Yount reminded us to sign up for “Guess Who’s Coming to Dinner” and for the Branson trip.

Cluster - Eldeen asked Bea, Barb and Kandy to pick a winner for the theme contest. Cluster will be held on September 29th, with registration at 9:00 a.m. A motion was made by Barb Yount and seconded by Pat Poretta that we split the In Kind money from the cluster between Community For Christ and Share The Harvest. Motion carried.

The meeting was adjourned and we stood and said the Lord’s Prayer.

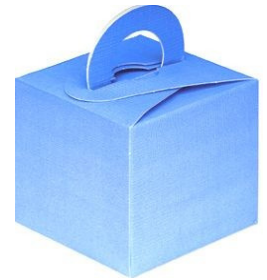
