## A WORD, MAYBE TWO FROM PASTOR DAVE

On Sunday, September 7, we will return to our regular worship schedule after 3 good summer months. The summer began with our Central States Synod Assembly in Springfield, MO, where we identified the fears that keep us from fully engaging in ministry and mission. Throughout the assembly the synod staff, through their meaningful and Christ-centered messages, lifted up the hope that calls us to more boldly embrace the reality that we live at God's table which extends beyond the church into the world that God loves and blesses. It is this hope in Christ and his promises that enables us every Sunday to reaffirm our mission statement: "Hearing God's Call And Responding In Love, We Share Jesus With All."

We shared the love of Jesus when we:

- + brought food to support the Buddy Pack Program – 38 children from 13 families.
- + provided school supplies to 32 students at Hurricane Deck School.
- + filled the Blue Box with food to help our Food Pantries in the community.
- + opened our facilities to the Community Blood Bank for the Blood Drive and Life Line Screening.
- + shared our old treasures through the Rummage Sale to raise funds for Social Ministry and CFC.
- + contributed through our weekly offerings to support Helping Hands Homeless Shelter, CADV, Share the Harvest, Community For Christ, Westlake Sr. Center and the ministries of the ELCA.
- + contributed through our weekly offerings to support pastoral ministry to our members and non-members (preaching, teaching, nursing home and hospital visitation, counseling, weddings, funerals).
- + gathered together for fellowship time after church and on cruise worship.
- + shared the love of Jesus wherever you cared for someone on your street, in your community, in your home, on your phone, in your prayers.

Now it is time to return to our fall educational program with Sunday School and Bible Class and that means more opportunities to share the love of Jesus. **On Sunday morning, September 14**, the adults will begin to discuss Luther's Small Catechism, led by Pastor Dave (see "Focus on Christian Education" on page 8 to see why). The children will continue to study Bible stories, focusing on the Gospel Readings for each Sunday. This class will be taught by Carol Hansen.

**The Women's Bible Study** on Wednesday mornings is in search of more ladies who want to learn more about the 4 Gospels. They have studied Mathew and Mark and are now focusing on Luke's Gospel. How are these Gospels the same? How are they different? Who were the first readers? These women take their time and have good conversations along the way. To join just show up at 9:00am. Linda Williams is the facilitator.

**The Men's Bible Study** group also happen to be looking for (not some ladies) but some men who enjoy talking about current events, sports and oh, yes, the Book of Revelation. It's an interesting book and it's central message is about Jesus and the Tree of Life mentioned in the Book of Genesis. We will be discussing John's Revelation from a Lutheran perspective. Led by "the Three Blind Mice."

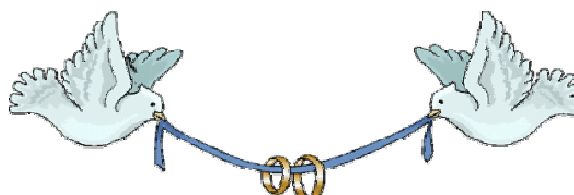

## **FOCUS ON...**

# **Christian Education**

The Christian Education Committee is responsible for the recruiting of qualified teachers for Sunday School and for other learning opportunities for youth and adults. They shall provide suitable teaching and worship materials published or approved by the ELCA. This committee orders the church's periodicals and books of family devotions and encourages families to use these devotions in their homes. One of the primary aims of the committee is to bring the call to the ministry of the Gospel and to other full time church vocations to the attention of qualified youth of the congregation.

The Christian Education Committee offers Sunday School and Adult Classes on Sunday mornings, a Bible study class for women on Wednesday Mornings and for men on Thursday mornings. A class for elementary school children is also offered on the third Wednesday of every month through the Kid's Klub. There are also some women who attend a community Bible Study once a week.

At best only 13% of our congregation is involved in any kind of Christian Education during the week. This is interesting because the Lutheran Church began in a university setting. Martin Luther taught at the Wittenberg University where the Reformation was born. He also led small group theological discussions, called "Table Talk," with his students.

2017 is the 500<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the Reformation. To prepare for this milestone in the Lutheran Church, we are offering you a chance to [study again Luther's Small Catechism](#). Most of you studied the Catechism in the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade, but I'd bet not many have even opened the book since then. And for all of you who did not grow up in the Lutheran tradition, this is your chance to more fully understand the basics of the Christian Faith. The Six Chief Parts of the Christian Faith include: The Ten Commandments (Ten Words of Life), The Apostles' Creed (God Three Times Over), The Lord's Prayer (How to Pray), The Sacrament of Holy Baptism (From Death to Life), The Sacrament of Holy Communion (Food for Travelers), and the Office of the Keys and Confession (Going It Together).

Let's see if we can turn that 13% into 31%!!!! Sunday mornings 8:30 a.m. to 9:15 a.m. beginning on September 14<sup>th</sup>.

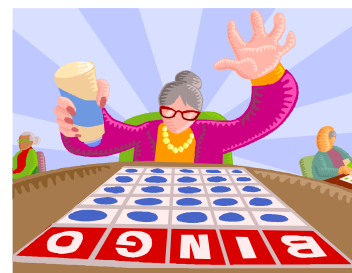
## SOCIAL MINISTRY


