2109 CENTRAL STATES SYNOD ASSEMBLY OFFERING During the Synod Assembly, June 6 - 8, the synod will be receiving an offering at both the gathering and closing worship services. At its April 16 meeting, the council approved a special collection for these ministries. The collection will be taken on May 5, May 12 and May 19. Please mark contributions "Synod Assembly". This year's offering will be designated for the following ministries: 1. **Young Adults in Global Mission** which invites ELCA young adults ages 21 - 29 into a transformative, year-long journey in international service in nine countries around the world; 2. **PMA Scholarships**. The Parish Ministry Associate Program (PMA) has been active in the synod, raising up and training leaders, many of whom are serving our congregations as the primary pastoral leader; 3. **Pantry Pack Program**, Salem Lutheran Church, Lenexa, KS, works with local schools to identify families struggling with food insecurity and hands out Pantry Packs of groceries one day a week.
