FROM PASTOR ED

Jesus' healing of the 10 lepers is a story about faith and thankfulness. (It is also about God's desire to bring life out of death and to restore those who have been pushed to the boundaries.) Jesus wonders that only one of the 10, the Samaritan, returned to give praise to God, and He declares that one's faith has made him well. Are we thankful for what God has done for us? Do we see the ways God has blessed us? Do we recognize how much God has done for us? Can we know the "wellness" of the Samaritan that comes from loving, thankful praise?
