

**FROM PASTOR ED**

"Then Jesus told them a parable about their need to pray always and not to lose heart." (Luke 18:1) How do you experience prayer? Is it easy? Do you look forward to spending time with God? Or do you find prayer difficult, stressful, boring? Or is it some of both? For Jesus prayer was a constant and expected part of the life of faith, but even for the disciples and those to whom Luke wrote his gospel, encouragement was needed. Our God not only encourages us to pray and gives us a day set aside to be in God's presence, God promises that our prayers will be answered. So, keep on praying. God (unlike the unjust judge in today's lesson) won't tire of hearing us and won't send us away empty.
